What happens to your general waste?

General waste is segregated into specific waste streams at our Materials Recycling Facility (MRF). Recyclates like paper, wood, plastic and metal are made into new products. Any residual waste is sent to an Energy From Waste plant where it is used to create electricity.

What happens to your paper and cardboard? Paper and cardboard is segregated at our Materials Reycling Facility (MRF) and sent to to a re-processing plant where it is recycled to make more paper and packaging materials.

What happens to your food waste?

Food waste is sent to an anaerobic digestion facility where it is used to generate renewable energy and organic fertiliser.





WHAT GOES INTO YOUR MIXED GLASS WASTE BIN?

- Clean, empty jars

- Ceramics or crockery
- Food residues

What happens to your glass waste?

Glass waste is sent to a specialist glass processing plant where is is washed, sorted and crushed to make new glass products.





WHAT GOES INTO CANS AND PLASTIC BOTTLES WASTE BIN?

- Plastic bottles
- Food packaging
- Milk bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Plastic bags
- Aluminium cans

- Glass
- Paper and cardboard

What happens to your waste cans and plastic bottles? The mixed waste is segregated into single waste streams at our Materials Recycling Facility (MRF). The recyclates are then taken for re-processing and become new plastic bottles and cans.
